4                   MR. TOM GOODIN: Go Kentucky.  
5                   ADJUTANT FINLEY-JACKSON: Dennis  
6 Woeltje, excused. George Scarborough.  
7                   MR. SCARBOROUGH: Here.  
8                   ADJUTANT FINLEY-JACKSON: Elizabeth  
9 Gonzales, excused.  
10                  ADJUTANT FINLEY-JACKSON: Cary  
11 Kellett, are you still here?  
12                  MR. KELLETT: I'm still here.  
13                  COMMANDER BOARDMAN: I'm not sure if  
14 that's a good thing or a bad thing. We still have  
15 two distinguished guests. Would either one of them  
16 like to repeat any words that you gave us so far?  
17                  AUDIENCE MEMBER: No veteran left  
18 behind. Check with your neighbor.  
19                  COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Sir?  
20                  AUDIENCE MEMBER: Anybody who's  
21 somebody remember this: Me.  
22                  COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Thank you. I  
23 now entertain a motion to approve the minutes of  
24 our previous Department Executive Committee  
25 meetings held on July 12th and 15th, 2018, during

1 Department Convention as published to each  
2 district. Is there a motion?

3 MR. GOOLSBY: Jerome Goolsby,  
4 Department Historian. So moved.

5 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Is there a  
6 second?

7 MR. ANDERSON: Anderson, 6th  
8 District. I second.

9 MR. BOECK: Steven Boeck, 5th  
10 District. Second.

11 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Speak up. She  
12 cannot read your hand. Is there any discussion?  
13 All in favor signify by saying aye.

14 (Responded aye.)

15 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: All opposed,  
16 nay.

17 (No response.)

18 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Motion passed.  
19 We now have a subcommittee report by Bob Maddox.

20 VICE COMMANDER MADDOX: Just had one  
21 issue come to the committee. We have three post  
22 closings we referred on to the state department for  
23 closing: Post 75, the Four Warriors; Post 141,  
24 Mission Pac-- Missouri Pacific; and Post 206, U.S.  
25 Marine Corps. We sent them on with approval to

1 close.

2 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Thank you, sir.

3 VICE COMMANDER MADDOX: I make a  
4 motion to ratify this.

5 MR. GOOLSBY: Goolsby, Department  
6 Historian, seconds.

7 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: We have a motion  
8 and a second. Is there any discussion? All in  
9 favor signify by saying aye.

10 (Responded aye.)

11 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: All those  
12 opposed, nay.

13 (No response.)

14 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Motion passed.  
15 Do we have any recommendations for  
16 new post charters?

17 ADJUTANT FINLEY-JACKSON: Absolutely  
18 none.

19 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Do you have any  
20 recommendations for post mergers?

21 ADJUTANT FINLEY-JACKSON: That would  
22 be negative, Commander.

23 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Do you have any  
24 recommendations other than those already posted for  
25 the post charter cancellations?

1                   ADJUTANT FINLEY-JACKSON: No,  
2 Commander.

3                   COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Thank you. Now  
4 open for new business. Got a couple announcements  
5 here. Make changes in appointments to our  
6 committees and commissions. On the Baseball  
7 Commission, David Voyles will be reappointed. Drew  
8 Wheatly will be reappointed. John Lisle to  
9 replace --

10                  ADJUTANT FINLEY-JACKSON: Josh.

11                  COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Josh Lisle. My  
12 mistake. Josh Lisle to replace Tom Rhoads. I need  
13 a motion.

14                  MR. GOOLSBY: Goolsby, Department  
15 Historian. I move that those appointments be  
16 approved.

17                  COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Second?

18                  MR. HOLTZ: R.E. Holtz, 3rd District.  
19 Second.

20                  COMMANDER BOARDMAN: I have a motion  
21 and a second. Do I hear any discussion? All those  
22 in favor signify by saying aye.

23                                 (Responded aye.)

24                  COMMANDER BOARDMAN: All those  
25 opposed, nay.

1 (No response.)

2 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: That motion  
3 passes. Also have Mr. Mike Larry Sweeney to be  
4 appointed to the Law and Order Committee. There  
5 was an opening. There was nobody to be replaced.  
6 Do I have a motion?

7 MR. GOOLSBY: Goolsby, Department  
8 Historian. Move that appointment be approved.

9 MR. BOECK: Steven Boeck.

10 MR. HOLTZ: R.E. Holtz, 3rd District.  
11 Second.

12 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Have a motion  
13 and a second. Is there any discussion? All those  
14 in favor signify by saying aye.

15 (Responded aye.)

16 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: All those  
17 opposed, nay.

18 (No response.)

19 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: That one passed.  
20 Do I have any other new business? Tom Goodin.

21 MR. TOM GOODIN: Tom Goodin,  
22 Alternate National Executive Committeeman. I would  
23 like to make a suggestion that we look into the  
24 price of wrapping our vans. I saw some up at  
25 Indianapolis that really called the attention of

1 the American Legion. I think they do a better job  
2 than just our little window decals. I don't know  
3 if it would be cost prohibitive or not. I think  
4 the Department should look into that, sir.

5 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Is that a motion  
6 or is that --

7 MR. TOM GOODIN: That's just a  
8 suggestion.

9 MR. KELLETT: Cary Kellett, Immediate  
10 Past Department Commander. I got a price on that  
11 two years ago, and depending on how detailed we  
12 want, it's approximately \$2,000 per vehicle. The  
13 wrap comes off easily. I don't mean that it's just  
14 going to blow off, but when we get ready to trade  
15 the vehicle in, it will be easy enough to remove  
16 that it won't affect the cost or the paint or  
17 anything like that once we decide to get rid of the  
18 vehicles.

19 MR. TOM GOODIN: Tom Goodin,  
20 Alternate National Executive Committeeman. While  
21 we're in discussion, I would like to ask Terry  
22 Lanning, the Finance Commissioner, if they've had  
23 any ideas on the cycle of trading the vans and, if  
24 not, would it be -- do we have enough money that we  
25 could maybe do one van to see if it draws

1 attention?

2 MR. LANNING: Terry Lanning, chairman  
3 of the Finance Commission. We are now using the  
4 policy as far as replacing vans, our vehicles,  
5 150,000 miles before we're replacing them. And  
6 we're also planning on when the Senior Vice  
7 Commander van gets to that point, we're not going  
8 to replace it. We'll be down to two. Right now  
9 we've got three. That's the answer to your first  
10 question.

11 The other question about the cost  
12 factor, is that what you're saying?

13 MR. TOM GOODIN: Well, Cary just --  
14 go ahead.

15 MR. KELLETT: Immediate Past  
16 Commander Cary Kellett.

17 When I priced it and everything, we  
18 were going to use the fund out of the Senior Vice  
19 Commander's advertisement fund, which I think the  
20 Senior Vice Commander still has an advertisement  
21 fund that he can use at his discretion, with  
22 approval, and that's the fund that we were going to  
23 use. I think at the time it was 5,000, 6,000,  
24 something like that.

25 MR. LANNING: Okay. Cary, what

1 you're talking about is we have a membership  
2 advertising budget of \$2,000 this year. It used to  
3 be more, but we've been cutting back. We haven't  
4 been using it, to tell you the truth. And so  
5 that's what you're talking about.

6 MR. TOM GOODIN: So do we have the  
7 funds to do a van this year and the second one next  
8 year, or would you rather that be put on the back  
9 burner?

10 MR. LANNING: It's not in the budget,  
11 let me put it that way, and we're trying to find  
12 ways to save money in the budget.

13 MR. TOM GOODIN: We're also trying to  
14 find ways to improve membership and get  
15 recognition.

16 MR. LANNING: I agree. I think  
17 unless we can drive the revenue to offset it, the  
18 answer would be no.

19 MR. TOM GOODIN: Let me ask you this,  
20 Hallie. Are you planning on using that \$2,000 for  
21 anything this year since it hasn't been used in the  
22 past?

23 SR. VICE COMMANDER WILLIAMS: Well, I  
24 was doing some radio. Right now they're free. I  
25 know eventually I'm going to have to pay something.



1 MR. TOM GOODIN: Well, we tried the  
2 radio in the past. That didn't do anything.

3 SR. VICE COMMANDER WILLIAMS: It's  
4 working in the St. Louis area.

5 MR. TOM GOODIN: It's just a  
6 discussion. There's no motion on the floor. You  
7 know, let's just table -- let's table the  
8 discussion, Commander.

9 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: We discussed it.  
10 There was never a motion, so we don't have to table  
11 it.

12 MR. TOM GOODIN: Let's see if we can  
13 find the funds next year. If we get those 4,000  
14 members to cut your pony tail, we should be able to  
15 do it.

16 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Terry, you might  
17 as well stay up here.

18 MR. LANNING: I don't have a report.

19 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: You don't have a  
20 report?

21 MR. LANNING: No.

22 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Nothing from  
23 finance. American Legion Riders director, is he  
24 here? Yes, he is. Don, because I'm not even  
25 trying it, Don. Just come on up.

1 MR. GERSPACH: Gerspach. Thank you,  
2 Commander. My name is Don G-Man Gerspach. I'm the  
3 Department Director for the American Legion Riders.

4 And in addition to reports from  
5 yesterday, I would just like to say great job to  
6 everybody across the state of Missouri in the  
7 donations to the National Legacy Fund. And I would  
8 add that there was one \$6,500 check that didn't  
9 make it to the Legacy Fund donation this year. It  
10 didn't clear the bank in time. It will be our kick  
11 start for the 2019 donation. It was from the  
12 American Legion family of Post 202 in Columbia.

13 And this year's ride captain, Jim  
14 Rosenberg, and the assistant director, Brian Sapp,  
15 are working out a plan for an escort for the  
16 National Commander when he comes here the middle of  
17 next month.

18 That's my report.

19 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Thank you, sir.  
20 Anything for the good of the order?

21 MR. GOOLSBY: Goolsby, Historian. I  
22 make a motion that mileage be paid upon the proper  
23 submission of signed paperwork to the Department  
24 Adjutant.

25 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Looks like it's

1 going to die for lack of second.

2 MR. GOTH: Second.

3 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: I have a motion  
4 and a second to pay everybody for their mileage one  
5 way. Have any discussion on that? Name.

6 MR. GOTH: Kenny Goth, NEC.

7 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: Thank you.  
8 Being no further discussion, all those in favor  
9 signify by saying aye.

10 (Responded aye.)

11 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: All those  
12 opposed, nay.

13 MR. TOM GOODIN: Since I'm going to  
14 donate mine back to the Department, I vote nay.

15 COMMANDER BOARDMAN: It's a close  
16 vote, but the ayes have it. Pass.

17 Any other business for good of the  
18 order? Uncover. Chaplain, please, one more time.
